Being involved with the LTMF Orchestra Academy, participating in the rehearsals, performances, master classes, and networking with musicians from around the country will provide you with the opportunity to grow both musically and personally. Along the way all of us here are dedicated to helping you reach your career goals.

Lake Tahoe Music Festival Orchestra Academy Application and Audition Procedures

- Applicants must be 18 years of age or older.
- All applications are non-refundable. Applications will not accepted after March 15, 2010 – 5:00 p.m. Pacific Time. No exceptions.
- Fees are \$25 for completed applications submitted no later than March 15, 2010
- Internet auditions must be submitted by March 15, 2010 – 5 p.m. Pacific Time. Auditions must include an excerpt from a standard concerto or sonata and two contrasting orchestral excerpts from the approved list. Auditions not to exceed four minutes.



Submissions Accepted By YouTube Limited Access URL

Create or sign in to your YouTube account and upload your video. Click "Edit Video Info," scroll down to the Broadcast section and select the "Private" option, then "Limited Access URL," and save settings by clicking the "Update Video Info" button. Provide the "Limited Access URL" to the Lake Tahoe Music Festival at allie@tahoemusic.org along with your name.

- All Finalists will be placed on the substitute list and may be called to substitute with the orchestra.
- LTMF will not provide copies of audition excerpts or solos.
- Accompanists are not permitted in your audition.
- All auditions will remain the sole property of LTMF and by submitting your online audition you agree and provide permission for the LTMF to use the clip for marketing purposes.
- All audition results will be given by e-mail no later than April 15, 2010.



- Membership is awarded on a season-by-season basis for up to three years with the understanding that participation in the program is subject to ongoing review by the CEO, Artistic Director, and other members of the LTMF staff.
- Musicians will be responsible for their own transportation to and from the Granlibakken Conference Center and Lodge, located in Tahoe City, California at the start and conclusion of their service. The LTMF will provide double accommodation housing, most meals, and a weekly stipend of \$425.

Foreign Nationals living within the USA: In addition to your application materials, audition and application fee, please provide photocopies of the following documents:

- Passport page(s) containing date of birth, country or city of birth, country of citizenship, and foreign address.
- ONE of the following documents (as applicable): I-20 from the school or institution you are attending - Permanent Residency Card (Green Card) - Employment Authorization Card.
